

# **2018 State Central Committee Application Instructions:**

- ✓ Complete and sign the Notification of Candidacy portion of this application
- ✓ Complete and sign the Ethics Disclosure Form portion of this application
- ✓ Provide a printed copy of your voting history displaying an official record of voting on a Republican ballot in each of the three (3) most recent General Primary Elections in Illinois (2014, 2016, 2018) **The ILGOP strongly advises applicants to vote early to ensure their 2018 primary vote is recorded with their County Clerk.**
- ✓ Provide a letter of recommendation from an elected Republican official who resides in your congressional district. Any elected Republican who appears on a partisan ballot is eligible to serve as a recommendation. If you have any questions on eligibility please contact ILGOP Deputy Executive Director Travis Sterling.
- ✓ Provide a biography and/or professional resume
- ✓ All completed applications must be received by ILGOP Deputy Executive Director Travis Sterling by mail, email, fax, or hand delivery **no earlier than Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at 9:00am and no later than 5:00pm on Monday, March 26, 2018. The ILGOP strongly advises applicants to utilize a hand delivery or a certified overnight service.** Mailed applications that are postmarked before the deadline, but received after **will not** be accepted.

# **Illinois Republican Party Bylaws**

## ARTICLE II. MEMBERS OF THE STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE

- A. Election. The members of the State Committee shall be the Republican State Central Committeemen or Committeewomen who are elected or appointed as provided by law and these Bylaws.
  - 1. No individual shall be eligible to serve as a member of the State Central Committee unless the individual has voted in the Republican Primary Election in each of the three (3) most recent General Primary Elections held in the State of Illinois as evidenced by the individual having requested a Republican ballot according to the official voting records of the election jurisdiction in which the individual resides. This General Primary Election voting requirement shall not apply to an election in which an individual: (a) who did not vote and can demonstrate they were on active military duty at the time of the election, (b) was not of legal voting age at the time of the election, or (c) was not a resident of the State of Illinois at the time of the General Primary Election and the individual can show proof of the voting Republican in the General Primary Election of the State in which the individual previously resided.
  - 2. State Central Committeemen shall be elected in the same manner as provided by law for the election of officers of county central committees and such election shall follow the election of officers of county central committees. Each elected precinct committeeman who is present at a county convention shall cast their vote for State Central Committeeman, one vote for each ballot cast (i.e., "weighted vote") in their respective precinct in the last preceding General Primary Election. The "weighted vote" for vacant precincts, and precincts not represented at the county conventions by elected precinct committeemen, shall be allocated to each candidate for State Central Committeeman based on the proportion of weighted votes the candidate(s) received from the elected precinct committeemen present at the county convention.
  - 3. Term limits. No member of the State Central Committee; deputy member of the state central committee; National Committeeman or Committeewoman; or State Chairman shall serve more than eight (8) consecutive years in the same office. This section is effective on January 1, 2015 but shall not apply to terms that are the result of vacancies or terms that have commenced prior to the effective date.

This Notice of Candidacy with attached proof of voting record and other application documents must be received by ILGOP Deputy Director Travis Sterling at the Illinois Republican Party office, 35 E Wacker Dr, Suite 400, Chicago, IL 60601, not earlier than 9:00am on Wednesday, March 21, 2018 and no later than 5:00pm on Monday, March 26, 2018, without exception. All candidates are strongly encouraged to hand-deliver their application documents, or to deliver via overnight mail service. A receipt for filing will be provided. Application documents will be accepted if sent by U.S. Mail, email, or fax.


